

Guidelines for Patch Design

Please submit patch design entries as follows:

- Each tribe can enter multiple designs for a given event.
- Patches can be any shape. While the Patch Template sheet can be useful it is not required that designs use one of those shapes.
- Please make sure each entry includes the child's name and tribe so that appropriate recognition can be made to the design winner.
- Patch designs must be submitted to the Guide Feather Bearer or Princess Feather Bearer by the Longhouse meeting shown on the Patch Design Schedule (see The Drumbeats).
- Entries will be narrowed to three by the Feather Bearer and then presented to the Guide or Princess Nation Council for final consideration.
- The child who created the design for the chosen patch will receive a wall plaque that displays an example of the patch along with their tribe and Indian name.
- Once a child's design has been selected for a patch, that child is no longer eligible for the remainder of that program year.
- Winner will alternate between the Guide and Princess Programs according to the schedule.
