Your car must be certified in order to race but you do keep custody of it after it's been inspected. Tribal chiefs and Nation Council members will be judging the cars in three design categories: 1) Automotive, 2) Native American, and 3) Most Unusual.

Safety comes first. Every racer should wear long pants and long sleeves, a protective helmet, and gloves. The starters will emphasize several things: try to go straight, but if you go off course stay in the car. Trying to get off is riskier than riding it out. *Never* try to stop the car by putting your foot on the ground.
