

Y-Guides Spring Campout

May 4 – 6, 2012 Camp Henry Horner

Friday, May 4, 2012	
4:00 pm to midnight	Camp open for arrivals. Follow signage to our camping area. Unload your cars at the loop near the pavilions and then park in the remote parking lot. Don't drive on grass. Pick up your firewood for your tribe from the pile at the bonfire area. Only take what your tribe ordered. Check with your chief.
Saturday, May 5, 2012	
All Day	Arrival. Follow signage to our camping area. Chiefs should check-in with Bob Solak, Event Coordinator, of the Blackfoot tribe for any last-minute announcements and to give final numbers.
Morning – 12:30 PM	Tribal activities – This is "open" time for your tribe to use as you want. The camp has some hiking trails, a lake to fish in, a skate park, tennis courts, etc. There are other groups at the camp that take part in organized, camp-run activities. We just need to steer clear of those areas that are in use.
12:30 – 2:00 PM	Climbing Wall open to Y-Guides (this is our group's slot for the climbing wall – other groups will be using it at other times of the day). Located west of our camping area along a trail leading west from the archery area.
3:30 PM – 4:30 PM	Archery open to Y-Guides (this is our slot for archery – other groups will be using them at other times of the day). Located just west of our camping area
4:40 PM -5:40 PM	Nation Games in our camping area. Sack Race, wheelbarrow race, tug-o-war, etc.
5:40 PM – 8:15 PM	"Open" time.
8:15 PM - ?	Graduation Ceremony and Bonfire. Located at the Fire Ring in our camping area, south of the pavilions.
Sunday, May 6, 2012	
8:30 AM	Breakfast at the Dining Hall
11:00 AM	Check-out time. Be sure to throw out all garbage bags in camp dumpster. Return all unused wood to fire ring area.

FIREWOOD: Pick up your firewood from the fire ring area. Chiefs should be sure to only take what your tribe ordered.

WATER/ELECTRIC: Available at the two pavilions and the bathroom building.

GARBAGE: Tribes should bring their own garbage bags. When full, dispose of the bags at the camp dumpster.

PICNIC TABLES: Picnic table availability may be limited. Tribes may want to bring folding tables as a backup for your camp site.

PARKING: After unloading, park at the camp's remote parking lot (along the entrance road). Do not drive on the grass.

HORSEBACK RIDING: The camp does not have stables. If you're interested, check out Chain-o-Lakes Stable at 8916 Wilmot Road (inside Chain O' Lakes State Park), Spring Grove, IL 60081-8104 Phone: (815) 675-6532
